

After which time entries will not be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 4, Section 4 of the Match Regulations.



**DIRECTIONS:** FROM I-94 East or West, Exit at <u>EXIT #275 (Cty F, Ixonia-Sullivan</u>). Go North on "F" 4 miles to Elmwood Ave. (Cty P). Turn West and follow the road 1/2 mile to Cedar Dr. Turn East on Cedar Dr. and take this into the parking lot. You can also come via 16 from Oconomowoc or Watertown. Cty. F meets Hwy 16 on the North. If you are coming from the East—do not get off at County F in Waukesha County—you need to go 20 miles further on I-94 and get off at exit 275.

### **EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE**

All dogs entered in this match must be A.K.C. registerable.

Dog's with Major Points or Champions of Record may not be shown in Conformation Classes.

Licensed Handlers may only show dogs owned by them or members of their immediate family.

Judges will not be required to wait for dogs.

Wins at sanctioned matches carry no A.K.C. Championship points.

Scores awarded at sanctions matches do not count as credit towards any Obedience Title.

Qualifying scores will be required in regular obedience classes.

Please exercise dogs in designated area only (East side of Parking lot) and please clean up after your dogs.

Do not use the cement ashtrays near the outside doors as waste baskets.

Dogs must be kept on leash when outside ring.

No powder or chalking permitted on the grounds.

No electricity available at this site for grooming (excluded for this year—see text box above).

No X-pens allowed in building.

No alcoholic beverages for consumption is permitted in the building or grounds.

\* **Generations Class**—This class is open to groups of 3 dogs representing 3 direct/consecutive generations which will be judged as a group.
